Operating safety

General notes

WARNING

Your attention must always be focused on the traffic conditions.

Only operate the AMG Performance Media when the traffic situation permits. You may otherwise be distracted from the road traffic conditions, cause an accident and injure yourself and others.

You must observe the legal requirements for the country in which you are currently driving when operating the AMG Performance Media.

Bear in mind that at a speed of just 50 km/h (approximately 30 mph) your vehicle is covering a distance of 14 m (approximately 44 feet) every second.

Declaration of conformity

The wireless devices of the AMG Performance Media comply with Part 15 of the FCC Rules.

Operation is subject to the following two conditions: 1) These devices may not cause harmful interference, and 2) These devices must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation. Changes or modifications not expressly approved by the party responsible for compliance could void the user's authority to operate the equipment.

Correct use

Observe the following information when using the AMG Performance Media:

- the safety notes in this Supplement
- the national road traffic regulations

Important

Only have work or changes to electronic components carried out at a qualified specialist workshop that has the necessary specialist knowledge and tools to carry out the work required. AMG recommends that you use an authorized Mercedes-Benz Center for this purpose. In particular, work relevant to safety or on safety-related systems must be carried out at a qualified specialist workshop.

Function restrictions

For safety reasons, certain functions are restricted or unavailable while the vehicle is in motion. You will notice this, for example, either because you will not be able to select certain menu items or because the AMG Performance Media will display a message to that effect.

Problem-free use

Run-on time

After the ignition has been switched off (e.g. for refueling), the AMG Performance Media continues to be active for approximately 5 minutes.

Operation



- ① Status bar
- ② Main function bar
- ③ Menu bar

Main function bar

To select between the functions: turn or slide the COMAND controller.

To change within the menu selection: select the function and press the COMAND controller.

Menu bar

To select between menu items: turn or slide the COMAND controller.

To switch to full-screen mode: select the menu item and press the COMAND controller.

To change to the main function bar: slide the COMAND controller.

Selection lists

To change a selection: turn **⏏** or slide **⏏** the COMAND controller.

To confirm a selection: press **⏏** the COMAND controller.

To exit the selection list: slide **⏏** the COMAND controller or press the **⏏** button next to the COMAND controller.

Buttons

To change a selection: turn **⏏** or slide **⏏** the COMAND controller.

To confirm a selection: press **⏏** the COMAND controller.

To exit the selection window: press the **⏏** button next to the COMAND controller.

History screen

The history screen can only be selected when the vehicle is stationary.

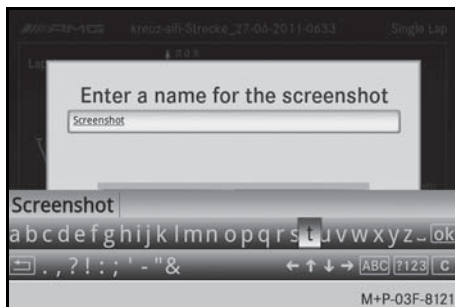
To open a selection list: press **⏏** the COMAND controller.

To move the cursor along the x-axis: turn **⏏** or slide **⏏** the COMAND controller.

To change to the menu bar: press the **⏏** button next to the COMAND controller.

Entering characters (speller)

Character entry is only possible when the vehicle is stationary.



1. To select a character: turn **⏏** the COMAND controller.
2. To confirm a selection: press **⏏** the COMAND controller.
A selection list is shown.

3. Complete the entry and confirm with **ok**.

or

3. To select a suggestion from the selection list: slide **⏏** the COMAND controller.
4. To confirm a selection: press **⏏** the COMAND controller.

Deleting an entry

1. To delete the last characters entered: briefly press the **c** button next to the COMAND controller.

or

1. To delete the entire entry: press and hold the **c** button next to the COMAND controller.

Note

For further information on entering characters, see the COMAND operating instructions.


Connecting the USB stick

WARNING

Only connect the USB stick when the vehicle is stationary. Otherwise, there is a risk of you becoming distracted from the traffic conditions and causing an accident.

1. Open the glove box.
2. Insert the USB stick.
3. Close the glove box.

Important

Before removing, deactivate the USB stick, see  page 14).


Otherwise, data on the USB stick may be lost or damaged.

Note

If the USB stick is not recognized by the AMG Performance Media, the file system of the USB stick is potentially damaged. Reformat your USB stick using a computer (file system FAT32).

Switching AMG Performance Media on/off

Switching on



1. Switch on the COMAND control panel, see the COMAND operating instructions.
2. Press the  button.

The AMG Performance Media is operational after approximately 60 seconds.

Switching off

1. Press the  button.

or

1. Select the  Mercedes star and confirm with .

Switch to COMAND.

Function Data

Using this function, you can call up graphically depicted, vehicle-specific data on temperatures, power and tires.

Menu Temp



Displays:

- coolant temperature
- engine oil temperature
- transmission oil temperature

Menu Power

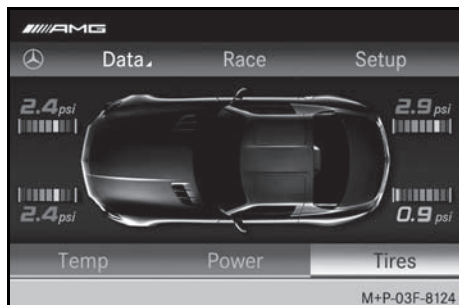


Displays:

- torque
- power
- accelerator position (0-100%)

Menu Tires

Displays the pressures in all tires.



Function Race


Only use the RACE function on closed race circuits.

This feature is only for use on roads and in conditions where high speed driving is permitted. Racing on public roads is prohibited under any circumstances. The driver is always responsible for following posted maximum speed limits.

The Race function offers additional display messages. Additionally, the route can be recorded and evaluated.

Note

The accuracy of recorded data is dependent on the quality of the received satellite signal. The AMG Performance Media may, in some cases, not receive satellite signals when the vehicle is in the vicinity of high buildings or trees, or located in a valley.

1. Confirm  the warning message.

Menu GMeter




Displays:

- brake pedal position (0-100%)
- lateral/longitudinal acceleration
- accelerator position (0-100%)

History: graphic display of the recorded values of the last 10 minutes. If a USB stick is connected, screenshots of the display can be stored on the USB stick.



Displays:

- lateral acceleration
 - steering angle (0-180°)
 - longitudinal acceleration
 - speed
1. Open History and press . A selection list appears.
- Reset History
 - Screenshot
 - Exit History

Note

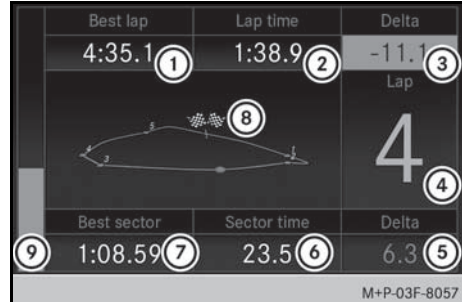
The history screen can only be selected when the vehicle is stationary.

Resetting stored values

1. Press  in full-screen mode.
2. Select **Reset Max** and confirm with .

Menu Track

Offers the possibility for any track to be divided in sectors, recorded and stored. Sector times, lap times and total race times are recorded for evaluation at a later time.




- ① Best time (lap)
- ② Current time (lap)
- ③ Difference between the current lap time and the best lap time
- ④ Lap number
- ⑤ Difference between the current sector time and the best sector time
- ⑥ Current time (sector)
- ⑦ Best time (sector)
- ⑧ Start/finish
- ⑨ Driven (laps in %)

The current position of the vehicle is identified by the red dot.

Note

If there is an improvement of a sector/lap time compared to the last lap, it will be displayed in green. A worse sector/lap time is displayed in red.

Two tracks are installed in the AMG Performance Media at the factory:


- Nürburgring (Nordschleife)
- Hockenheimring
 1. Press  in full-screen mode.
 2. To select a function:
- History: graphic display of recorded values (see (▷ page 9))
- Select Track: select a track from the overview
- Record Track: record a track in the overview (see (▷ page 9))
- Delete Track: delete the desired track from the overview

Note

Preinstalled tracks cannot be deleted from the AMG Performance Media.

- Import Tracks: import track data in gpx format from a connected USB stick (folder name "Tracks")
- Export Tracks: export track data in gpx format to a connected USB stick
- Exit Track: exit Track menu

Recording a track

1. Select the function Race → Track → Record Track and  confirm.
2. Confirm recording with Ok.
3. Drive around the desired track carefully and determine the sectors using Set sector.

Note

You can improve the accuracy of sectors being recorded by reducing your speed during recording.

4. Complete track recording with Done.

Note

The AMG Performance Media automatically recognizes when a lap on a race circuit is completed.

5. Store the track by confirming with Yes.
6. Enter the track name and confirm with Ok.



Note

Character entry is only possible when the vehicle is stationary. Otherwise, a track name will be assigned.

7. Store the track by confirming with Enter.

History (track)

If a USB stick is connected, screenshots of the display can be stored on the USB stick.

To move the cursor along the track route: turn  or  slide the COMAND controller to move the cursor slowly or quickly.

1. Open History and press .

A selection list appears.

- **Single Lap:** graphic display of the recorded values of one lap




Displays:

- speed
- accelerator position (0-100%)
- brake pressure
- steering angle (0-180°)
- gear


at the selected time point.

If **Single Lap** is selected, the first lap is shown automatically.

To change the display:

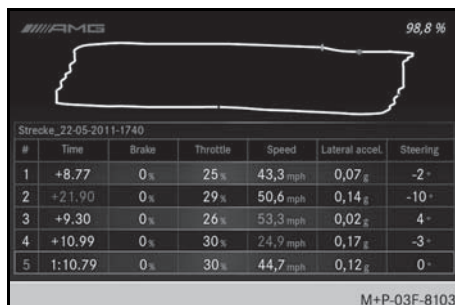
1. Press  in full-screen mode.
2. Call up the **Select Lap** function.

A selection list appears.

3. Select a lap from the list and  confirm.

The selected lap is displayed graphically.

- **Matrix:** comparison of recorded values of up to five laps



Displays:

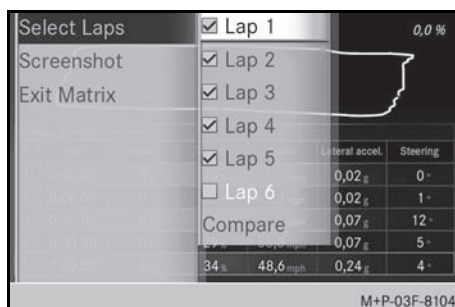
- the difference between the current lap time and the best lap time
- brake pedal position (0-100%)
- accelerator position (0-100%)
- speed
- longitudinal acceleration
- steering angle (0-180°)

at the selected time point.

If **Matrix** is selected, the first five laps are displayed automatically.


To change the display:

1. Press  in full-screen mode.



2. Call up the **Select Laps** function.

A selection list appears.

3. Select five laps from the list and  confirm.

4. Select Compare.

A comparison of the selected laps is displayed.

- Parameter: comparison of a recorded value for up to five laps



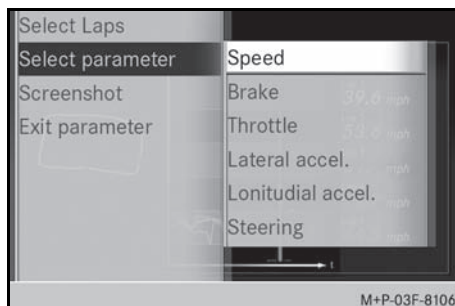
If Parameter is selected, the speed of the first five laps is displayed automatically.

To change the display:

1. Press in full-screen mode.
2. Call up the Select Laps function.
A selection list appears.
3. Select five laps from the list and confirm.
4. Select Compare.
A comparison of the selected laps is displayed.

To change parameters:

1. Press in full-screen mode.



2. Call up the Select parameter function.

A selection list appears.

3. Select parameters from the list and confirm.

A comparison is displayed.

- Import: import race data in .bin file format found on a connected USB stick and named "history_YYYY-MM-DD_HH-MM-SS.bin" (e.g. history_2011-06-01_15-36-54.bin)

Note

Make sure that the name of the file has the correct form. Otherwise, the AMG Performance Media cannot access the file.

If several files are on the USB stick, the most recent file will be imported.

- Export: export race data in .txt and .bin file formats to a connected USB stick

Note

The history screen can only be selected when the vehicle is stationary.

Menu 0-60 mph



Displays:

- speed
- time
- track

The measurement of acceleration starts automatically when the vehicle pulls away (movement of the wheels). Measurement stops after 10 seconds or when a speed of 60 mph has been reached.

The measured values are displayed digitally until the next measurement is started.

Menu 1/4 Mile



Displays:

- speed
- time
- track

The measurement of acceleration starts automatically when the vehicle pulls away (movement of the wheels). Measurement stops after 20 seconds or when a distance of 1/4 of a mile has been driven.

The measured values are displayed digitally until the next measurement is started.

Function Setup

Menu Car



Determine specific vehicle settings for a driving situation (transmission mode, suspension settings, ESP® mode).

1. Select the desired setting package and confirm.
- Active Setup: current settings
 - Setup: stored settings
 - Race Start: settings to begin a race

Note

For further information on Race Start, see the vehicle Owner's Manual.

2. Select and open the vehicle settings (transmission mode, suspension settings, ESP® mode).



3. To make settings: turn the COMAND controller.
4. Confirm the setting.
5. To store settings made: select in the Setup submenu.

Note

The ESP OFF setting cannot be stored.

Calling up stored settings

1. Press the button for approximately 3 seconds.

A tone will sound to confirm that the saved settings have been called up.

Menu Performance Media


Units

You can select which units are to be used to display the following vehicle data:

- temperature
- torque
- power
- speed
- pressure

Factory Reset

You can reset the entire AMG Performance Media system to the factory settings. All data is deleted, including personal settings (e.g. stored values). Resetting is recommended before handing over or selling the vehicle, for example. If necessary, data stored in the system can be exported to a USB stick, see (▷ page 8).

1. Select **Factory Reset** and  confirm.
2. **Reset to factory settings** and confirm with **Yes**.


The system will then reboot automatically. This takes approximately 60 seconds.

Update APM

Updating the system software

1. Connect the USB stick in the vehicle, see (▷ page 6).
2. Turn the ignition key to position 1, 2 or 3, see the vehicle Owner's Manual.
3. Select **Setup** → **Performance Media** → **Update APM** → **Update System**.

The system will then reboot automatically. This takes approximately 60 seconds.

4. Select the desired procedure and  confirm.
 - **Reboot:** abort the software update and boot the AMG Performance Media with the currently installed software version
 - **Start Update:** start the software update, see (▷ page 15)
 - **Factory Reset:** reset to the factory settings

Eject USB Stick

Ejecting a USB stick safely.

Important

Before removing, deactivate the USB stick. Otherwise, data on the USB stick may be lost or damaged.

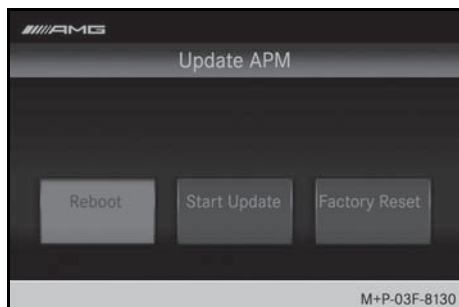
System Info

System information is displayed.

Software update

Data sets in the system software can age, making a software update necessary to ensure optimum operation of the AMG Performance Media. You can obtain further information on software updates from your authorized Mercedes-Benz Center.

New system software updates are made available if necessary at: www.mercedes-amg.com.



1. Download software updates on a computer with an Internet connection and store them on a USB stick in a folder named "updates" under "update.zip".

Note

Make sure that the correct spelling is used. Otherwise, the AMG Performance Media cannot access the folder.



WARNING

Never run the engine in an enclosed space. The exhaust fumes contain poisonous carbon monoxide. Inhaling exhaust fumes is hazardous to health and can lead to loss of consciousness and death.

2. Connect the USB stick in the vehicle, see (▷ page 6).
3. Turn the ignition key to position 1, 2 or 3, see the vehicle Owner's Manual.
4. Select Setup → Performance Media → Update APM → Update System.

The system will reboot automatically. This takes approximately 60 seconds.

5. Select Start Update and  confirm.

The software update starts. The update process can take up to 30 minutes.

Note

In order to protect the battery, the update should take place when the engine is running.

COMAND can be used during the update process without limitation.

Licensing agreement

Components of the software used in the AMG Performance Media are open source programs, which are licensed according to the licensing conditions of the General Public License, Version 2 (GPL).

The licensing text of the GPL and further open source components can be found in the "AMG Performance Media - License Agreement" Supplement.
